

French Video Club!

School Year 2007 – 2008

There is a French Video/DVD Club at both Sunset Elementary,
and Carver Middle Schools.

Students who are members of the club receive an age/level appropriate French videotape/DVD once a week. A parent volunteer will select random tapes (for Sunset) or DVD's (for Carver) from a box of tapes marked for that grade level and distribute them to those children who are members of the Club during their French Content Class. This usually takes place on a Thursday or Friday before the weekend.

The children should then bring back the tape on or before the following Wednesday or Thursday and place it in the Video Box in their French Content Classroom/Homeroom. The parent volunteer will then collect those tapes at the beginning of class, and return before the end of class with a new tape for each child. Each tape is tracked so that it is not given to the same child twice. Parents are asked to rewind the tapes and make sure that their children return them the following week.
